Introduction to MemberMouse 1-Click Registration

Thank you for purchasing MemberMouse 1-Click Registration!

MemberMouse 1 Click Registration allows you to register new members or upgrade existing members to any **free** membership level by doing only one action – clicking a link!

So once a user clicks on the link, he will be automatically registered to the relevant membership level as defined in the plugin's settings.

The plugin supports ALL autoresponders that integrate with MemberMouse:



Options to Registering Members:

There are 3 options to register members using MemberMouse 1-Click Registration:

1. **Register through your autoresponder** – By adding a unique registration link to emails you send through your autoresponder
2. **Roll members from another membership site** – By adding a unique link to one membership site and rolling the members to another membership site
3. **Add a 3-field registration form** – By embedding a simple 3-fields signup form to any post or page

Complete Activation Process Summary in 8 Steps

Follow the steps below to have MemberMouse 1-Click Registration activated and fully function on your membership site.

Detailed information about each step will be given further down this manual:

Step #1: Plugin Download

Download MemberMouse 1-Click Registration Core plugin zip file from the Purchase Receipt you received to your email.

Step #2: Plugin Installation & Activation

Install the plugin just like any other WordPress plugin from the Plugins menu > Add New.

Step #3: License Activation

Activate the plugin's license using the license key you received to your email.

Step #4: Defining the General Settings

Before generating the links you will need to go over the general settings of the plugin that can be found in the Settings tab.

Step #5: Generating the Links

In order to generate the links or the signup form you will need to go to the Generator tab and define the relevant settings.

Step #6: Embedding the Links

After defining the settings and generating the links all you need to do is copy-paste them to the right place according to their use.

Step #7: Using the Shortcodes


In the Dashboard tab you will find all the shortcodes that can be copy-pasted to the After Registration page to display the member his login details.


Step #8: Testing the Registration

After you copy-pasted the links or signup form to the right location you need to test them and make sure they are working correctly.

Step #1: Plugin Download

Download MemberMouse 1-Click Registration plugin zip file from the Purchase Receipt you received to your email as seen in the screenshot below:

Step #2: Plugin Installation & Activation

MemberMouse 1-Click Registration plugin can be installed easily, just like any other WordPress plugin.

You can install it 2 ways:

1. Upload the folder found inside the zip file to your plugins' folder in your WordPress installation
2. Go to the plugins menu, click the "Add New" and choose the zip file you have downloaded

Step #3: License Activation

After you have installed and activated MemberMouse 1-Click Registration, you will find the plugin's activation setting inside the WordPress menu under: MM Extensions » MemberMouse 1-Click Registration.

To activate the plugin you purchased, you need to insert the license number in the right place under "License Key" as seen in the screenshot below:



Step #4: Defining the General Settings

Before generating the links you should go over the general settings of the plugin that can be found in the Settings tab.

In the Settings tab you can set the following options:

- **Link Expired Error Page** – The page users will be redirected to if the registration link is expired (The expiration date is set in the Generator tab)
- **General Error Page** – The page users will be redirected to in case of an error in the registration process
- **Send Email to Admin** – Get admin email notification every time a new user registers through a MemberMouse 1-Click Registration plugin registration link / signup form
- **New Member Username Format** – Set the username format to be first and last name, email prefix or full email
- **Member Welcome Email** – The welcome email members get when the registration is completed successfully
- **Admin Notification Email** – The notification email the admin gets every time a member registers

Screenshots:

MemberMouse 1-Click Registration - Settings

Link Expired Error Page: Homepage
Choose the page a visitor will be redirected to if the link is expired.

General Error Page: Homepage
Choose the page a visitor will be redirected to if the registration process encountered an error.

Send Email to Admin: Send Admin Email for every new member.
When this field is checked an email will be sent to the website administration for every new member that is registered. The email format is the same one that is set inside Wishlist Member email settings.

New Member Username Format: First name & Last name Email Prefix Email Address
Choose the desired username format you want for every member that is registered in the one click registration process. The First name & Last name option will create a username that consists from the member' first and last name separated with a period.
The Email Prefix option will create a username that consists from the member' email address prefix (the part before the @ sign)
The Email Address option will create a username that consists from the member' email address

























Step #5: Generating the Registration Links

With MemberMouse 1-Click Registration you have 3 different and unique registration options:

- **Autoresponder registration link** – Register members via your autoresponder
- **Rolling members' registration link** – Roll members from another membership site
- **Signup form** – Register members via a simple 3-fields signup form

The registration links / signup form can be generated via the Generator tab under MM Extensions » MemberMouse 1-Click Registration.

The Generator Tab:

- **Select a membership level** – The membership level members will be registered to when clicking the registration link
- **Select the membership bundle/s** – The bundles members will be registered to when clicking the registration link
- **Select the autoresponder you are using** – In order to generate the correct link so members will be automatically registered straight from the email you send
- **Select the after registration page** – The page members will be redirected to after the registration
- **Automatic login after registration** – Can be Yes or No
- **Set an expiration date** – If you want to link to expire you can set an expiration date for the link (optional) to create urgency
- **Math Captcha** – Relevant to the signup form and allows you to add math Captcha to the form to prevent spam registrations

The Links Generated:

After clicking on the Generate button you will see get these details in the same screen, below the Generate button:

Autoresponder Registration Link

Supports all autoresponders and registers members directly from emails you send to your mailing lists in 1 click only.

This is the link generated by the MemberMouse 1-Click Registration you add inside the email:

Autoresponder Mail Merge Integration Link

This link should be used inside your autoresponder. Each autoresponder has a different format so make sure you have selected the correct auto responder.

Rolling Members Registration Link

When members click on the link generated on membership site A they will be automatically registered to membership site B in 1-click:

You can roll people from one MemberMouse membership site another to another using this HTML code:

3-Fields Registration Form

Add a 3-fields only signup form in every post or page you like to register members to your membership site:

Simple Signup Form

You can also create your own one-click registration form, where the only information your prospects have to fill out is their first name, last name, and email address.

All other registration details are generated automatically

Step #6: Embedding the Links

After defining the settings and generating the links all you need to do is copy-paste them to the right place according to their use.

Option #1 - Autoresponder Mail Merge Integration Link

1. Go to the Generator tab inside the plugin, choose the relevant settings and click on the Generate button
2. To get the 1-click registration to work all you need to do is copy-paste the autoresponder link into any email you send to your email list
3. Once a user clicks on the link he will be automatically registered and logged-in to the site, plus will be redirected to the Thank You page

Option #2 - Roll members from another MemberMouse website

1. Activate MemberMouse 1-Click Registration in the **NEW** membership site where you want to register members to
2. Go to the Generator tab, choose the relevant settings and click on the Generate button
3. Copy the HTML code under the headline: "Register new members from another MemberMouse website"
4. Go to the **OLD** membership site where you want to roll members from and paste the HTML code in the text editor of every relevant post or page. That's it!

Please note: In order for the link to work and register members from the old site to the new one, members need to be logged in to the old site.

Option #3 - Simple Signup Form

1. Go to the Generator tab inside the plugin, choose the relevant settings and click on the Generate button.
2. To make the signup form to work all you need to do is copy-paste the HTML code inside the text editor of every post or page inside your membership site.

Want a 1-field registration form?

You can hide the First and Last name fields to make the form display only the email.

All you need to do is follow these steps:

Step #7: Using the Shortcodes

Since MemberMouse 1-Click Registration registers members to the site automatically, they will need to get important details, such as their username and password, in order to be able to login to the site in the future.


In the plugin's Dashboard tab you will find all the shortcodes that can be copied and pasted to the after registration page to display the member his login details, including:

- Auto-generated username
- First name
- Last name
- Password
- Email
- Level name
- Action (new member/ upgraded member)

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Since the information displayed in the shortcodes is sensitive, it will be available for **30 minutes** from the first time the page was loaded. Please add a note to your members to save the information on their computer.

You can use the below shortcodes in your after registration page to display the new member his membership information:

- `[wlcr_username]` - Display the new member his auto-generated username.
- `[wlcr_firstname]` - Display the new member his first name.
- `[wlcr_lastname]` - Display the new member his last name.
- `[wlcr_password]` - Display the new member his auto-generated password.
- `[wlcr_email]` - Display the new member his email address.
- `[wlcr_levelname]` - Display the new member the level he was registered to.
- `[wlcr_action]` - Display a label of 'new' for a new members or a label of 'upgraded' for an existing member that has been upgraded to a new level.

`[wlcr_new_member]` Content `[wlcr_new_member]`
Display this content only to a new member.

`[wlcr_member_upgraded]` Content `[wlcr_member_upgraded]`
Display this content only to a member that was already exists and his membership was upgraded to a new level.

Step #8: Testing the Registration

After you copy-paste the links or signup form to the right location you need to test them and make sure they are working correctly.

Checking the Autoresponder Link:

In order to check the autoresponder link all you need to do is send a test message of the email that includes the 1-click registration link in it to your email.

When you receive the email, click on the link and see if the registration process is complete.

Important: please make sure that the email you are using doesn't already exist in your membership site's database.

Checking the Rolling Members Link

In order to check that the link for rolling members from one membership site to another is working correctly all you need to do is go to the **OLD** membership site where you pasted the 1-click registration link to.

In order for the 1-click registration link to work you need to make sure:

1. That you are logged-in to the **OLD** membership site
2. That you are not already registered to the **NEW** membership site with the same email

Now you can click on the link and see if you are being automatically registered to the **NEW** membership site.

Checking the Signup Form

In order to check that the signup form works all you need to do is enter the relevant post or page and fill-in the form's fields.

Before filling-in the signup form please make sure that:

1. You are not logged-in to the site
2. You are registering with a new email that does not exist in the database

What to do if the Registration Process is Not Working?

If you have encountered a problem in the registration process, please go to the [Contact Information section](#) for more instructions.

FAQS

Can MemberMouse 1-Click Registration plugin be used for paid membership levels as well?

No, the plugin works for free membership levels only.

Can I change the after registration redirection page?

Yes, you can set a different redirection page to each membership level separately simply and easily from the plugin's Generator tab under "Select After Registration Page".

Can MemberMouse Auto Registration work with any membership plugin?

No, MemberMouse 1-Click Registration is a MemberMouse dedicated plugin.

How will members get their login details?

MemberMouse 1-Click Registration allows you to add simple shortcodes to the After Registration page with the log-in details and they will be available for 30 minutes (for security reasons), so they have enough time to save them.

What details can I display members using the shortcodes?

Username, first name, last name, password (auto-generated), registration email, level name, action (new/ upgrade) and a content box with your message
