Introduction

Thank you for purchasing Wishlist Pay Per Post Shortcodes!

Wishlist Pay Per Post Shortcodes allows you to create the perfect flow for your membership site and manage your paid posts easily with shortcodes.

The shortcodes

These shortcodes allows you to display certain content to specific users only, including:

- Making specific content inside the post visible only to visitors who hadn't bought the post
- Making specific content inside the post visible only to members who bought the post
- Displaying a list of all the posts a certain member has bought
- Displaying the member his last purchased post

| Shortcode | Description | Uses |
|---|--|---|
| [wlppp_is_not_owner]your content[/wlppp_is_not_owner] | The content inside the shortcode is visible only to visitors who haven't purchased the post (in the excerpt) | To display the post's price, Buy Now button/ link etc. |
| [wlppp_is_owner]your content[/wlppp_is_owner] | The content inside the shortcode visible only to members who have bought the post | To display an icon in the excerpt what posts the member has access to |
| [wlppp_member_purchased_posts] | Displays a list of all the posts a certain member bought | To display the list inside the Member's Dashboard |
| [wlppp_last_purchase] | Display the member his last purchase | To display inside the Thank You page |

The Sidebar Widget

Wishlist Pay per Post Shortcodes plugin also includes a powerful widget to increase the engagement of your members to your site and generate you more sales.

The widget allows you to display a list of the user's most recent purchased posts from the sidebar.

You can choose to display between 1 to 10 posts that are organized according to purchase date.

The widget allows you to also display these messages:

Red callout boxes with arrows point to the following elements:

- Widget's title** (points to the Title field)

- Text before the posts' list** (points to the Text to display before posts list field)
- Text after the posts' list** (points to the Text to display after posts list field)
- Message to appear if no purchases were generated by the user** (points to the Message to display if no purchases exist field)
- Message to non-logged in users** (points to the Message to display if a user is not logged in field)

At the bottom of the panel are buttons for 'Delete | Close' and 'Save'.

Settings

In the settings tab you can customize the messages that appears to users who enter a post with the below shortcodes but are not logged-in to the site / who haven't purchased any posts yet :

- **[wlppp_member_purchased_posts]** (Displays a list of all the posts a certain member bought)
- **[wlppp_last_purchase]** (Displays the member his last purchase)

Installation

Wishlist Pay Per Post Shortcodes can be installed easily, just like any other WordPress plugin.

You can install it 2 ways:

1. Upload the folder found inside the zip file to your plugins' folder in your WordPress installation
2. Go to the plugins menu, click the "Add New" and choose the zip file you have downloaded



License Activation

FAQS

Is the plugin necessary for using the pay-per-post feature?

When we first started using Wishlist's feature, we discovered that it is missing some very important settings, which led us to develop a new plugin in order to use it as we want.

Wishlist Pay Per Post Shortcodes does 4 crucial actions that Wishlist Member doesn't allow:

- Make specific content in the excerpt visible only to user who hadn't bought the post (To display the post's price, Buy Now button, certain content etc.)
- Make specific content in the excerpt visible only to users who bought the post (To display an icon that indicates what posts the user has access to etc.)
- Display the user a list of all the posts he bought (To allow quick access to all posts from the Members Dashboard)
- Display the user his last purchased posts (To allow quick access to the post from the Thank You page)

Where can I use the shortcodes?

You can use the shortcodes in any post or page you need.

Can I use html coding inside the widget?

Yes, of course.

Can I customize the widget's CSS?

Yes, you can customize and tweak the CSS to your needs to attract attention to the widget.

Does the plugin have any conflicts with other plugins?

As far as we know, the plugin does not conflict with any other plugin. Wishlist Pay Per Post Shortcodes keeps a very strict code method so the chances that it's causing any problem are very low. If you have any problems or conflicts, please try to disable the plugin and see if the problem still exists. If it does, please contact our support helpdesk.

Does the plugin integrate with every membership site platform?

No, Wishlist Pay Per Post Shortcodes is a Wishlist Member dedicated plugin.
